Millions of people are now connecting their personal computers to telephone lines so that they can “go online”. The Internet is being used to find and share all kinds of information. The Montpelier Exempted Village Schools has developed a homepage to share information with not only the local community, but virtually the world. The school’s homepage will be in support of the following goals: The school’s web page(s) shall ...

- inform the community about school events.
- be used to publish student work.
- be a source of reference for various types of research.
- be used as an instructional tool for students.

The Internet is a global “network of networks” and is not governed by any entity. This leaves no standardized limits or checks on the kind of information that is maintained by and made accessible to Internet users. Most individuals who use online services are polite, responsible, and respectful. But, like any endeavor there are some risks. To minimize these risks we are implementing the following guidelines in publishing and maintaining our school’s homepage:

- Web pages will not include material that does not support the Educational Goals of the Montpelier Ex. Vil. Schools.
- Web pages will not include links to sites that do not support the Educational Goals of the Montpelier Ex. Vil. Schools.
- Web pages will not publish home addresses or private telephone numbers.
- A parent’s permission will be required to publish a student’s photograph with his or her name on the school’s homepage.
